

## GCC 2017 – Logistics 1-0-1

### VENUE:

We'll spend most of our days on beautiful Ashesi Campus and in the nearby township of Berekuso. GCC participants will be hosted in shared students accommodation just outside the campus gates. Internet is available on campus as well as in the student hostels.

*Please note: There is limited lodging capacity in student hostels. While we made sure to reserve spaces for Senior Fellows and Conference Delegates, it is important to confirm your participation ahead of time.*

For participants staying overnight, we charge 70, - USD / day, which covers for meals and (shared) accommodation. For Junior Fellows, those expenses are part of the Fellowship and will be covered by the Melton Foundation.

### VISA:

All travellers require a **valid tourist visa** to enter Ghana. For details, please check the information provided by Ghana Immigration Services (see <http://bit.ly/2o0eAfQ>) and contact the Ghanaian Consulate in your country of residence.

In case there is no Ghanaian Embassy or Consulate in your country of residence, please get in touch at least 2 month prior to the conference. Our partners at Ashesi can help facilitate the visa application process and coordinate a visa-upon-arrival in this case.

Please note: The Melton Foundation will cover the expenses for visa application only for Junior Fellows participating in the GCC.

### VACCINATION:

The government of Ghana requires proof of **yellow fever vaccination** for all persons. Travelers may be required to present it at the port of entry in Ghana.

For further health information, consult with your doctor (ideally, 4-6 weeks) before your trip to get vaccines or medicines you may need.

*Please note: The Melton Foundation does **not** cover expenses for yellow fever vaccination or other health prevention.*
